*The national flag of the Russian Federation is a rectangular cloth of three horizontal stripes: the upper - white, middle - blue, lower - red.*



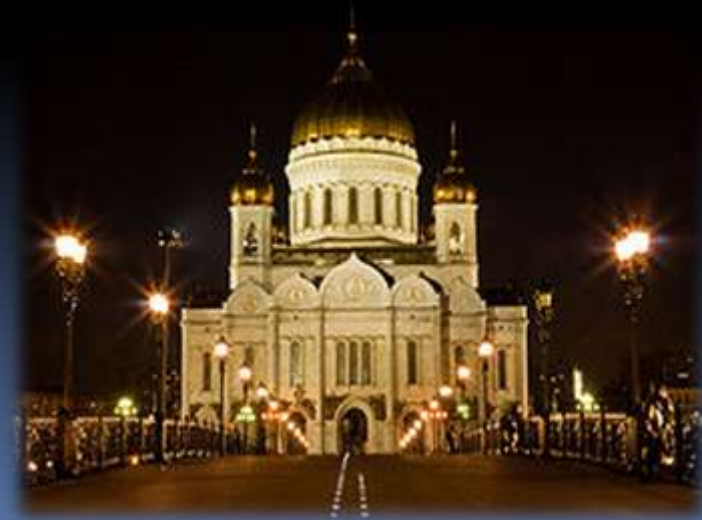
